Good Housekeeping Checks

Good housekeeping checks are concerned with ensuring that goods, office supplies and waste materials are stored and controlled so that they are not a potential fire hazard. Depending on your circumstances and business, your checks might be carried out to ensure:

The course is for those nominated to the role of Fire Marshal / Fire Warden within a business. It is a legal requirement for every employer to nominate competent persons, usually referred to as Fire Marshals or Fire Wardens, to assist with fire evacuation.

The approximate duration of this training is 1 hour.
